## How to put water in munchkin bottle warmer

Normally, to warm up the milk for a baby, in a bottle, you need hot water and a little bit of time. You can heat up water in a container in the microwave and then drop in your bottle and leave it for a couple minutes. You could also boil the water first, then dunk the bottle in there. Either one of those methods of warming up bottles will take at least 5 minutes if not more. As a parent you know that even a few seconds can make the difference between a hungry baby and a hungry-crying-yelling baby so time is of the essence when warming up milk or food. Best way of warming up milk bottles The best way of warming up your bottles is with a bottle warmer. Bottle warmers save you time and effort. Generally, to warm up 1 to 2 ounces of liquid it will take you about 2.5 minutes with the munchkin bottle warmer. Check out the video below to get an idea of how it works. This is probably one of the best investments that you can make during the first years of your babies' life. For us, it was actually a gift, but we would have bought it anyway. This model that you'll see in the video is one that plugs into the wall, and it isn't one of the battery operated bottle warmers. But if you have a power outlet, you could use this as a portable bottle warmer or even as a travel bottle warmer, you just need electricity. It's pretty portable and lightweight so it's pretty versatile. It's lightweight and very simple to use. The Munchkin bottle warmer instructions are simple and you won't even need them. Simply fill the water reservoir and replace it back into its slot. Then place the bottle with milk in the basket and place the cover ring over the opening and turn the timer on to get the bottle warm. I wish I could tell you exactly how to warm up the different amounts of milk, but each case will be slightly different and you'll eventually be able to guess pretty accurately based on your own bottles and how much quantity you're warming up each time. For example, we have a few different size bottles so each one takes different time to heat up. We have little tiny Medela bottles of 30 ml, and then the taller skinny ones for about 85 ml and we also use the fatter bottles that hold up to four ounces. How does the baby bottle warmer work? It's simple, the device has a heating element in the center at the bottom. Then there is a basket that sits about a quarter inch above the heating element. You place the baby bottle on that basket so it doesn't come in contact with the heating element and melt. There is a reservoir for water that provides water and fills in the gap between the basket and the heating element. When you turn the timer on, the heating element quickly brings that water to a soft boil and the steam produced is what heats up the milk in the bottle. The timer controls the heating element and boom, in a couple minutes you have warm milk. The one flaw with the Munchkin bottle warmer Because of the different sizes of the bottles, sometimes the steam that warms up the bottle has more or less room to escape the heating chamber. This is actually just about the only flaw with the device. There is a ring that goes over the holding basket when you use the device, but the ring is one size only. If we warm up the skinny bottle, then the gap between the ring and the bottle is wider and it lets more steam escape faster so we have to leave the bottle longer than if we used the fatter bottle. I wish it came with two or three size rings, even a perforated "full" cover would be nice because the tiny 30ml bottles I mentioned earlier actually are short enough to fit that way. But all in all the device is pretty cool and it works as advertised. I would say that it is the best bottle warmer for breast milk and other types of food, even formula. I don't see why you couldn't use it to thaw out and warm up soft food when your baby is old enough to eat solids. If I haven't convinced you that you should get this for your baby, why don't you go check out the video I made below, or read reviews and comments in Amazon. It should be clean, dry, and cool in temperature before heating. It helps to have it near a sink, since it uses water. Make sure it's away from upper cabinets, since it does release steam. You don't need to preheat it, which also saves time. Have your bottles or food jars close by, since this warmer heats up fast. When you're ready, plug it in. Step 2 - Fill the Warmer with Water Take the included Measuring Cup from its holder and fill it with water to the desired fill line. The fill lines on the cup use an alphabet system from A to F. It depends on the size bottle you have, whether it's a standard or wide mouth bottle, and its temperature before warming. Generally speaking, you'll use less water for room temperature bottles and jars, and more water for chilled or refrigerated bottles and jars. Keep in mind that you may have to adjust the amount of water to obtain the perfect temperature. A handy chart is included in the warmer instructions so that you don't overflow. Measure the water exactly every time you use the machine. If too much water is put in the warming chamber, you'll heat the bottle too long and the temperature will be too high. Then you run the danger of milk spilling out. Pour the water into the Warming Chamber. Replace the Measuring Cup back on its holder on the side of the machine. Step 3 - Add the Basket, the Bottle, and the Ring After you've poured in the water, place the Lift-Out Basket into the Warming Chamber. Always do this before adding your bottle or jar, to prevent damage and over-heating. Now put the bottle or jar into the warmer. Position the Adapter Ring on top of the basket. If it doesn't fit around the bottle, don't use it. Step 4 - Warm Up Press the "On" button on the Munchkin Bottle Warmer. This also turns on the Indicator Light, which means the warmer is working and has started its heating cycle. One of the best features of this bottle warmer is how fast it heats up. It takes less than two minutes. Step 5 - Ready to Go The light shuts off when the warming cycle is complete, so take the bottle or jar out immediately to prevent further heating. If it's not warm enough, use slightly more water next time. Add an additional half a teaspoon of water at a time to prevent overheating. Conversely, if the bottle or jar isn't warm enough, reduce by half a teaspoon of water each time to tweak the final temperature. Step 6 - Stay Safe Since this is an electric machine, caution needs to be taken to prevent electric shock. Make sure it's unplugged before cleaning. Do not use with extension cords, either. Children should not be operating this bottle warmer. Also, take five minutes between each warming cycle to allow the machine to cool. Don't use the Munchkin Bottle Warmer when it's still warm. With the exception of the car bottle warmer, the warming systems evenly warm food to the appropriate temperatures in as little as 90 seconds using steam. The alarms and automatic shut-off features in some of the Munchkin bottle warmers help prevent scalding and nutrient losses in food. By using your Munchkin bottle warmer correctly, you can safely feed your baby when she's hungry without needing a pot of hot water or microwave. Place the lift-out basket inside the warming chamber. Fill the measuring cup that comes with the warmer with water to the appropriate fill line and pour the water into warming chamber. The proper fill line depends on the amount of milk or food you want to warm and the food's temperature before you warm it. Place the bottle of milk or jar of food into the basket that's inside the warming chamber. Put the adapter ring over the top of the basket only if it fits around the bottle. If it doesn't easily slide over the bottle, don't use the adapter ring. Push the "On" button. Remove the bottle or jar from the warmer using the lift-out basket when the indicator light no longer illuminates. Wait at least five minutes before using the bottle warmer again. Unplug the bottle warmer from the electrical outlet. Pour the water out of the warming chamber. Munchkin Car Bottle Warmer Instructions Place the bottle warmer's heating band around the bottle or jar of food. Tighten the band around the bottle by squeezing on the clip and pulling the band. The bottom of the bottle or jar should touch the safety switch. Plug the end of the warmer into your car's power outlet or cigarette lighter outlet. Push the "On" button. Check the milk or food's temperature every five minutes. Unplug the warmer from the adapter when the food is the desired temperature. Remove the bottle from the warmer before giving it to your baby. Munchkin Night and Day Bottle Warmer and Cooler Place the lift-out basket into the bottle warmer's front warming chamber. Fill the water reservoir with water and place it into the bottle warmer. Place the bottle or jar of food into the basket that's in the warmer. The bottle or jar shouldn't touch the sides of basket. (See Reference 3, pg. 2) Put the adapter ring over the top of the lift-out basket if it slides on easily. If it doesn't, don't use the adapter ring. Plug in the warmer and turn it on by pushing the "On/Off" button once. Push the "Increase Time" and "Decrease Time" buttons to set the amount of time that you want the warming cycle to last. Press the "Start" button. Remove the bottle or jar using the lift-out basket after the warmer beeps three times. Wait at least three minutes before warming another bottle or jar. Unplug the warmer. Pour out the excess water from the water reservoir. Clean the bottle warmer with a damp cloth or a sponge and mild, soapy water. Do not submerge the warming unit in water. Only use the bottle warmer indoors and on flat surfaces. Always shake the bottle or stir the food before giving it to your baby, and test the temperature of the milk or food you warmed before feeding your baby. Supervise the bottle warmer while you use it, and don't use it if it is damaged. Avoid touching the hot surfaces in the bottle warmer. Do not use glass bottles with the warmer unless they're made from thermo-resistant glass.
