PDF files can include blank form fields that a user can fill out on his computer. If you have a PDF file that includes empty form fields, but the text you try to enter the form field is too big or small, you can adjust the font size of the input text using Adobe Acrobat. Start Adobe Acrobat on your computer. Click "File" and select "Open". Switch to the position of the PDF file where you want to change the font size of the form field. Click "Tools" in the File menu and is around "Advanced Change". A drop-down menu is displayed. Browse and click on "TouchUp Text Tool". Right-click on the PDF form field you want to change the font size and select "Property". A Property window appears. Click on the "Text" tab at the top of the window and click on the up or down arrow for the next arrow to the "font size" to adjust the font size. Click "Close" to save the changes. If you have a PDF form field with a font too small or too large, the PDF font change is an important step to fill the form so that it is readable. The process depends on whether you have a free version or paid Adobe Acrobat, but in most cases, you can make changes to fill the form so that the content fits into the field. In some cases, you can not make changes. If you do this, you may be able to make changes if the author of the PDF rule options. Compile and signs Check most form fields for PDF documents, Adobe says. This feature is especially useful if the author of the document has not form fields to the document but the spaces left to fill in the content. Or click on the "Fill & Sign" on the toolbar to the right of the document tools, go to "Sign" and then "Fill & Sign" from along the top menu, or go to "Tools" and then "Fill & Sign". Select "When asked who will be filling the form, and then I would have everything you need to adjust the font size.
