What pokemon can i evolve with the unova stone

This guide covers the Unova Stone and what you need to know about it.What Is a Unova Stone?An Unova Stone is an evolution item that was added to Pokémon GO along with the initial release of Unova. Unova is the 5th generation of Pokémon coming initially from the release of Pokémon Black and Pokémon White and consists of entirely new and unique Pokémon. Unlike other generations, there are no baby variants or evolutions of Pokémon from other generations. Similar to the Sinnoh Stone, the Unova Stone can be used to create exclusive evolutions for your Unova Pokémon.Unova Stone Evolution ListIt takes one Unova Stone to make an evolution. As of September 2019, that's perhaps all you'll need because there is only a single Pokémon accessible to everyone that can be evolved with the stone.Lampent into Chandelure with Stone + 100 Candy Pansear into Simisear with Stone + 50 Candy Passage into Simisage with Stone + 50 Candy Panpour into Simipour with Stone + 50 Candy Mincino into Cincino with Stone + 50 Candy Munna into Musharna with Stone + 50 Candy Eelektrik into Elektross with Stone + 100 Candy Pansear, Passage, and Panpour are regional exclusive Pokémon and Mincino, Munna, and Eelektrik are not yet released as of September 2019. If you happen to get a Unova Stone, you may only be able to use it on Lampent for now! Lampent can be found in 10km eggs, so start walking!How to Get an Unova StoneAs of September 2019, the only way to get an Unova Stone is to complete your Research Breakthrough task. This means you'll have to do a Research Task for seven days. It does not have to be seven days in a row, simply seven individual days of having completed at least one Research Task and you'll complete your Breakthrough, potentially granting you a stone. Unfortunately, it is not a guaranteed drop, so you may not even get it after 7 days!It's expected to be made more available in the future, similar to other evolution items. When this is done, you'll have a for more options just as you do with regular evolution items.A good way is to reach your seven-day Pokéstop reward. The streak rewards you for catching Pokemon or spinning Pokéstops at least once a day for seven days. After seven days of spinning Pokéstops, you are guaranteed a rare item. Of course, it may not be an Unova Stone, but that is the only way to guarantee a rare item. It also only takes consistency in that you can't miss a day, otherwise, it's easy to do.While friends are the best way to earn experience, you can now also earn rare items from friend gifts, making them that more valuable. Make sure to keep up on your gifting to maximize your chances. Remember, you can open up to 20 gifts per day, so be sure to have enough friends to keep that number going. If you don't have enough friends, check out local Pokemon groups on Discord, Facebook, Reddit, etc., so you can find a list of IDs to add and start gifting.Otherwise, keep spinning Pokéstops and gyms as much as you can to keep rolling the dice. Unfortunately, the drop rate for rare items, in general, is less than 1%, so finding an Unova stone may be a 1 in 1,000 or less event.Final ThoughtsIt's a strange decision from Niantic to only allow a single Pokémon evolution for the Unova Stone upon release, not counting the regional exclusives. This is very different than the Sinnoh Stone which came with quite a handful, and many more were added later on. It's more like the original stones which came with only one or two evolutions. However, you should still immediately start grinding for Unova Stones as you can be sure that the other evolutions already acknowledged will be released soon and it would not be surprising if more were to follow. Plus, depending on what is added, later on, there are likely going to be many very powerful options just as there were with the Sinnoh Stones that you'll want to add to your raid or PvP teams. The Unova Stone and candy will be consumed, and you'll have a new Simisear. How to evolve Panpour into Simipour Evolving your Panpour into Simisear works in the same way as with the other evolution above: To evolve your Pansear into Simisear, you will need to have a Unova Stone with you in your bags. You will also need to have all 50 candy, in the same way as with a normal evolution. On your Pansear Pokémon's screen, select the evolution through the usual in-game menu. The Unova Stone and candy will be consumed, and you'll have a new Simisear. How to evolve Mincino into Cincino Evolving your Mincino into Cincino works in the same way as with the other evolution above: To evolve your Mincino into Cincino, you will need to have a Unova Stone with you in your bags. You will also need to have all 50 candy, in the same way as with a normal evolution. On your Mincino Pokémon's screen, select the evolution through the usual in-game menu. The Unova Stone and candy will be consumed, and you'll have a new Cincino. How to evolve Eelektrik into Elektross Evolving your Eelektrik into Elektross works in the same way as with the other evolution above: To evolve your Eelektrik into Elektross, you will need to have a Unova Stone with you in your bags. You will also need to have all 100 candy, in the same way as with a normal evolution. On your Eelektrik Pokémon's screen, select the evolution through the usual in-game menu. The Unova Stone and candy will be consumed, and you'll have a new Elektross. How to evolve Lampent into Chandelure Evolving your Lampent into Chandelure works in the same way as with the other evolution above: To evolve your Lampent into Chandelure, you will need to have a Unova Stone with you in your bags. You will also need to have all 100 candy, in the same way as with a normal evolution. On your Lampent Pokémon's screen, select the evolution through the usual in-game menu. The Unova Stone and candy will be consumed, and you'll have a new Chandelure. How to get the Unova Stone The Unova Stone is obtained from spinning Pokestops and Gyms. There is a very low drop chance of around 1% per spin to receive a Unova Stone or any of the other evolution item, and there is an equal chance of obtaining each of the 5 currently available items. There's no way to ensure that the Unova Stone will drop, but with only 4 other items, there's a greater than 50% chance that you'll receive one once you've spun over 250 Pokéstops. The 7th day streak bonus gives you a very high chance of obtaining one of the evolution item, but it's not believed to be guaranteed. Usage Trivia All Pokémon, that to evolve into them there is evolution item required, cannot be neither caught in the wild, hatched from an egg nor be a Raid Boss in the gym and the only way to acquire them is the evolution. Historically, in the Pokémon game core-series, the following conditions described below will take place when one of these items are given to a Pokémon to hold: Pokémon capable of holding either a Dragon Scale, King's Rock or Metal Coat will evolve when traded. Pokémon capable of holding either a Sun Stone or Up-Grade will evolve when leveled-up. On the official support page for Pokémon GO, Deepsea Scale and Deepsea Tooth were mentioned. The Sinnoh Stone was first discovered in network traffic on November 6th, 2018.[2] Graphic design of Sinnoh Stone hints that it is made of diamond and pearl materials which is reference to Pokémon: Diamond and Pearl games in which Sinnoh region was introduced. Similarly to Sinnoh Stone, graphic design of Unova Stone is made of black and white materials which is reference to Pokémon: Black and White games in which Unova region was introduced. During Hatchathon in 2018, claiming Research Breakthrough guaranteed a Sinnoh Stone. During the February 2019 Community Day, Trainers were guaranteed to receive up to five Sinnoh Stones as a reward from Trainer Battles; in order to evolve their Piloswine into Mamoswine.[3] No Sinnoh Stone was guaranteed on August 2019 Community Day for Gallade evolution. During the February 2020 Community Day, Trainers were guaranteed to receive two Sinnoh Stones as a reward from one set of GO Battle League; in order to evolve their Rhydon into Rhyperior.[4] Porygon family is the only evolutionary line that requires two different evolution items. Spinning PokeStops and Gyms tend to be a great place to start. They can also be found as rewards for research tasks, quests, Team GO Rocket battles, and GO Battle League victories. If you're a Pokemon Go trainer looking to grab themselves an Unova Stone, and wondering what Pokemon can evolve with one, you've come to the right place. Let's run through how to get them, and how to use them. Seasoned veterans of the mobile game, which is available on Android and iOS devices, might already know the function of the Unova Stones. For those who aren't aware, they can be used to evolve some species of Pokemon, and are quite rare commodities. While the Sinnoh Stone is used to evolve Pokemon from previous generations, all of the Pokemon that can use the Unova Stone originate in the Gen 5 region of Unova, which first appeared in Black and White on the Nintendo DS. How to get Unova Stones in Pokemon GO NianticVisiting PokeStops is key to finding Unova Stones in Pokemon Go. Right now, there are only a few ways to get an Unova Stone in Pokemon Go, and the bad news is that it's not the easiest thing to achieve. If you don't already have one, it might take you a while to get one. It's possible to get an Unova Stone by defeating a Team Go Rocket Leader, or by defeating Giovanni, as these battles will reward you well. Unova Stones are a potential reward for winning, but that's not guaranteed. If you earn seven stamps over seven days, you'll get a Research Breakthrough, which could reward you with a Sinnoh Stone. Here's how you can unlock a Research Breakthrough and earn rewards: Open up the Pokemon Go app. Visit your nearest PokeStop. Check out your new Field Research tasks and complete one. Repeat this process for seven consecutive days (for a week, basically). On your last day of rewards, you will receive a reward and that may be an Unova Stone. It's worth noting that this isn't a guaranteed way of grabbing an Unova Stone in-game, but it's the best shot you have got right now. So keep plugging away and hopefully, luck will be on your side. Which Pokemon can evolve with an Unova Stone? NianticMunna evolves into Musharna with an Unova Stone. Now you know how to get your hands on these rare items, let's take a step back and look at which Pokemon need an Unova Stone to evolve in Niantic's mobile game. Below is the full list that of Pokemon that need them to evolve, although this will depend on which ones are active and available to catch in-game, of course. Passage evolves into Simisage (Unova Stone and 100 Candy) Pansear evolves into Simisear (Unova Stone and 100 Candy) Panpour evolves into Simipour (Unova Stone and 100 Candy) Mincino evolves into Cincino (Unova Stone and 50 Candy) Lampent evolves into Chandelure (Unova Stone and 100 Candy) Munna evolves into Musharna (Unova Stone and 50 Candy) As seen in the list, you won't just need to have the Unova Stone to actually evolve many of the Pokemon that need them. You will need to have acquired at least 50 Candies as well, with many actually needing 100 Candies. With Unova Stones in short supply in Pokemon Go, it will probably take you a while to evolve every single one of these creatures. But as they don't appear in the Wild, this is the best way to add them to your Pokedex right now.
