Merge pdf files together online

By Amy Dombrower Portable Document Format (PDF) is a widely used format for finalized electronic documents, interactive forms and documents that are going to be commercially printed. The format can be viewed using any basic PDF reader. PDF content cannot be changed easily, but tools exist to provide assistance. The popular PDF creation software Adobe Acrobat not only can create individual PDF documents but also can merge multiple PDFs into one single document. Click the "File" menu. Select "Combine," then "Merge Files into a Single PDF." Click the "Add Files" menu. Select "Add Files" to merge individual files or "Add Folder" to merge all the files in a single folder. Browse your computer's files and select the folder or files you want to add. Press "Control" to select multiple files at once. Click "Add Files." The files you select will be added to the list of files. Rearrange the sequence of the files by clicking and dragging a file to a new position in the order. Choose the file size you prefer at the bottom of the window. Click "Combine Files." Wait while Acrobat converts the files into one single PDF. Save the new merged PDF document. Click the "File" menu. Select "Combine Files." Click "Add Files" to merge individual files. Browse your files and press "Ctrl" while selecting multiple files. Click "Add Files." To merge a folder, click "Add Folders," select the folder you want to add, then click "OK." The files will be listed in the "Combine Files" window. Rearrange the order of the PDFs by selecting and dragging a file to a new position. Select the file size and conversion setting you prefer. Click "Next." Select "Merge files into a single PDF." Click "Create." Wait while Acrobat completes the merging process. Click "Save." Enter a filename for the new merged PDF and select a destination folder for it. Click "Save." These days, you can share files using all of the different cloud storage providers like Dropbox and OneDrive, but if all you want is a super easy way to share files with people, Jumpshare might be worth a look. Note: Jumpshare is also available for OS X as well. What's Different About Jumpshare? The primary selling point with Jumpshare is that it can naively handle over 200 file formats in the browser. So when you share a file with somebody else, they will be able to view the file in their browser, no software (or account for them) required. Jumpshare's HTML5 file viewer works for almost any type of file. The second major selling point is that Jumpshare is extremely easy to use: you just drag and drop a file onto the icon to upload it, and the share link is immediately on the clipboard, ready to paste. Or you can use the sharing options in the tray icon's popup menu. If you have the Plus version, you can make a link self-destruct after a certain number of days or you can disable download so they can only preview the file in the browser. Just email them directly from the popup interface, or you can copy / paste the link and send them a regular email in your preferred client instead. If you like to take and share a lot of screenshots, Jumpshare has that option built right in. Their web panel also allows you to easily deal with your files, and works a lot like the web panels for Dropbox or anything other storage service. The difference is that this one is focused around file sharing. The free version of Jumpshare gives you 2GB of storage, but the paid Plus version gives you up to 1 TB of storage and a ton of extra features. To do a search by filetype just means that you're narrowing down the results to show only the ones that include files. When Google is used to find files, you can locate books, documents, sheet music, Microsoft Word files, and more. Google can locate a large handful of files, and some are even indexed, meaning that you can search for files that have a specific term in them. When you use that operator in your searches, the file extension that you tie with it immediately narrows down all results to show only that file type. For example, you might search for PDFs on Google if you're looking for books in that file format: filetype:pdf "jane eyre" What follows the file type is the search term that you want Google to look for within the files. This same pattern works for any of the file types. For example, to locate resumes samples in the DOCX file format: filetype:docx resume If you're a musician and you want to use Google to find sheet music, your best bet is to use the PDF file-type search: "moonlight sonata" "sheet music" filetype:pdf Google supports lots of advanced commands, any of which you can combine with a filetype search to dig even deeper into the files you're looking for. filetype:docx site:edu inurl:resume In this first example, we're looking for MS Word files, but the site search eliminates all top-level domains except EDU sites, and the inurl command lets us find only the Word files where the URL contains the word resume. filetype:pdf site:gov report inurl:2001 For this search, we're finding PDFs that have the word report in them, but only if the URL also includes 2001. The idea here is to locate files that have been categorized in a 2001 folder on the site's server, which will likely find reports published in that year. filetype:kml kansas A KML file search like this one shows custom map files related to the Kansas search term. Some results might include map annotations for bicycle trails, lakes, car repair shops, etc. You could also find KML files that cover a specific map visualization, such as meteors (e.g., search for filetype:kml meteor). filetype:swf blooms Can't find an online game that you used to love to play? A filetype search for SWF files might help, so long as the game is available as a Flash file. Thanks for letting us know! Tell us why! Need to convert a DOC file to PDF? Or maybe a PDF to a JPG file? There will always come a time when you'll have to convert a file of one type into another and you will probably want to do it as fast and as cheap as possible. Of course, if you work in an office and have to convert files everyday, your company will probably purchase a commercial converting application and that's definitely the best option. However, if you only need to convert files a couple of times a year and you don't want to drop \$50 on a program that just converts Word docs to PDF files, then you only other option is to use free online conversion tools. These are basically sites that let you convert between many different formats and are usually free for small conversion projects. They make money by trying to get you to sign up if you need to convert more files or larger files, etc. In this article, I'll mention a couple of online conversion sites that I have used and that do a pretty good job, though they are not perfect. Even with expensive conversion software, you'll always run into cases where the conversion output isn't quite right and in those cases, you just have to try another service or edit your file to make it easier to convert. ZamZar ZamZar has been around since 2006 and even though they push to get you to sign up for their monthly plans, the service still works well for free too. Of course, when things get busy for them, all the conversions for free users get pushed to the back behind all paying users. Depending on the time and day you use the service, it can take anywhere from 2 mins to 2 hours to get your converted files. When they first started off, they only supported a few dozen types of files conversions, but now they can do over 1200 types of file conversions. This includes documents, audio, video, images, ebooks and more. As I mentioned earlier, though, it's only useful for a small number of files of relatively small size if you're using the free service. To use it, just start filling out the section at the top. First, click Choose Files and select the file you want to convert. Automatically, the drop down in Step 2 will populate with the formats that are available for conversion. For a Word doc, these were my conversion options: Then just type in your email address and click on Convert. When your conversion is complete, you'll get an email with a link to your converted files. Online-Convert.com Another good online conversion tool is Online-Convert.com. Unlike Zamzar, this site is completely free with no paid options at all. They basically survive on donations and ad revenue it seems. Technically, there doesn't seem to be a limit on the number of files you can convert, but I'm sure there's some cap at a point. Anyway, the main page is broken down into sections such as audio, video, image, document, etc. Go ahead and click the drop down and choose the format you want to convert your files to and click Go. Then click Choose Files and select the files you want converted. The nice thing about this site is that it lets you also choose from your Dropbox account if you want and it has some optional settings for using OCR and even being able to pick a different language for the source file, though your mileage will vary greatly. Another nice feature is the fact that you don't have to type in any email address or any personal info! Just click Convert file and it will convert instantly and download right to your computer. No waiting! After that, the service gives you a whole slew of other options in case you want to do something else with the file: Those are two sites that I've used and have had good results with in terms of speed and conversion quality. You can also download conversion software, but it's nearly impossible to find a freeware program that can handle so many different types of conversions. If you need to convert video files, you have a lot more free options like the awesome HandBrake. When it comes to document conversions, those free options just don't exist.
