The play won an Obie Award; shared this with Adrienne Kennedy's Funnyhouse of a Negro. [2] The game was revived in 2007 at the Cherry Lane Theater, starring Dula Hill, and in 2013 was restored by Rashid Johnson in the Russian and Turkish baths in the East Village. Lula guesses that Clay tried to get his sister for a party to have sexual relations with him when he was 10 years old. Clay is shocked by his apparent past knowledge of it and says that she must be a friend of Warren. Lula is glad Clay is easy to handle and puts the apple into her leg. It feeds her. She tells Clay to invite her to the party he is going to. At this point, we do not know if she is clear whether she is actually going to a party, but she tells her she really is. Lula vaguely alludes to sexual relations for her "flat" after the "party". Do we know if she is real or conveniently invented by Lula. Clay rejoices at the apparent call of Lula for him and keep a hopeful attitude to have sexual relationships together. However, he does not push her hoping on her and waits for Lula to make the offer. Lula is irritated by Clay not to fall for his tactical manipulators. She changes from strategies and monitors Clay's Anglo-American speech, her university education and her three-button clothing. She lost being black and passive. She dances in a R & B style and tells the Clay to join her and "do the unpleasant. Scrub bellies." Clay, who does not respond initially, ends up grasping her and throwing it down. Clay accuses Lula from knowing nothing but "luxury". He hit her twice and tells her to leave him alone. Clay is thrown into a monochrom. Clay suggests that whites let the blacks dance "black" dances and make music "black". He explains that these segregation actions assume the anger of the American blacks towards whites and distract them from accessing the "intellectual legacy of the white man". Clay states that if the blacks stopped trying to cure his pain through the dance, music, participation, religion, or concentrate on moving up in American society, and was coldly rational as White people, the blacks would only kill all whites and would be made with racism in America. Clay says if he would take Lula's words into his heart, he should kill all the white people he knows. Although Clay says all this, he deeply rejects this action plan. He states that he does not want to kill and that he prefers to be ignorant of the problem. He says he would rather choose to be ignorant of racism, do not try to get rid of him fighting with whites. Once Clay makes your confession, Lula changes strategies again. Clay does as if to leave, but she coldly, rationally stabbed him twice to the heart. She directs all other passengers, black and white, in the train car to throw his body out and go out in the next stop. The game ends with Lula looking at another young black man who has just boarded the car now especially empty. Old Old Trains Trains Steps in the compartment and tips Lula your hat. Symbolism The game's title evokes images of Dutch ships that carried slaves through the Atlantic. The metric's car itself, infinitely traveling the same course, is symbolic "the course of the story." Driver: She is portrayed as a witty happy man, murmuring a song for himself, and swinging down the hall to a music in his head. He does not appear until the end of the game.
