Practical Order Sheet: Lesson C4.3

Aim

Carry out displacement reactions

Apparatus - Demo

- Copper; zinc; magnesium; iron
- Solutions of the sulphates of each of the above metals
- Test tubes/ spotting tiles
- Pipettes

What to do

1. Place small amount of one metal sulphate into 3 test tubes
2. Add a small piece of a different metal to each of the test tubes
3. Make observations to see if a displacement reaction has taken place (colour change will be the most obvious sign)
4. Repeat process for each of the other combinations of metal and metal sulphate from the table shown on power point
