Domestic and wild animals
 Some animals can be kept at home by humans. These animals are called **domestic animals**. The animals which cannot be kept at home are called **wild animals**. Some examples are given below.

Domestic animals: Dogs, Cats, Cows, Buffalo, Sheep, Horses, Pigs, etc.

Wild animals: Lions, Tigers, Elephants, Snakes, Leopards, Gorillas, Hyenas, etc.

Animals with fur or scales: Some animals like rabbit, bear and monkey have soft fur on their bodies.



Some animals like fish, snake and crocodile have scales.



The Universal Declaration Of Human Rights

In his 1941 State of the Union address US president Franklin Roosevelt had called for the protection of what he termed the "essential" Four Freedoms: freedom of speech, freedom of opinion, freedom from fear and freedom from want, as its basic war aims. This has been seen as part of a movement of the UNO that sought to make human rights part of the conditions for peace at the end of the war.



After Roosevelt's speech, the United Nations Charter "affirmed faith in fundamental human rights, and dignity and worth of the human person" and committed all member states to promote "universal respect for, and observance of, human rights and fundamental freedoms for all without distinction as to race, sex, language or religion".

When the atrocities committed by Nazi Germany became public knowledge around the world after World War II however, the consensus within the world community was that the United Nations Charter did not sufficiently define the rights it referenced. A universal declaration that specified the rights of individuals was necessary to give effect to the Charter's provisions on human rights.



Canadian John Peters Humphrey was called upon by the United Nations Secretary-General to work on the project and became the Declaration's principal drafter. The Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) was adopted by the General Assembly on 10 December 1948 by a vote of 48 in favour, 0 against, with 9 abstentions. The UDHR is considered a milestone document in the history of human rights.



The Declaration has since then been translated into over 250 languages and dialects, making it the most widely translated document in the world. The Declaration arose directly from the experience of the Second World War and represents the first global expression of rights to which all human beings are entitled. It consists of 30 articles which have been elaborated in subsequent international treaties, regional human rights instruments as well as national constitutions and laws.



Today, the UN, through organisations like the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), works toward improving health and welfare conditions and securing the basic human rights for children and adults around the world. Financed largely by the contributions of member states, UNICEF has helped feed children in more than 100 countries, provided clothing and other necessities, and sought to eradicate diseases such as tuberculosis, whooping cough, and diphtheria.
